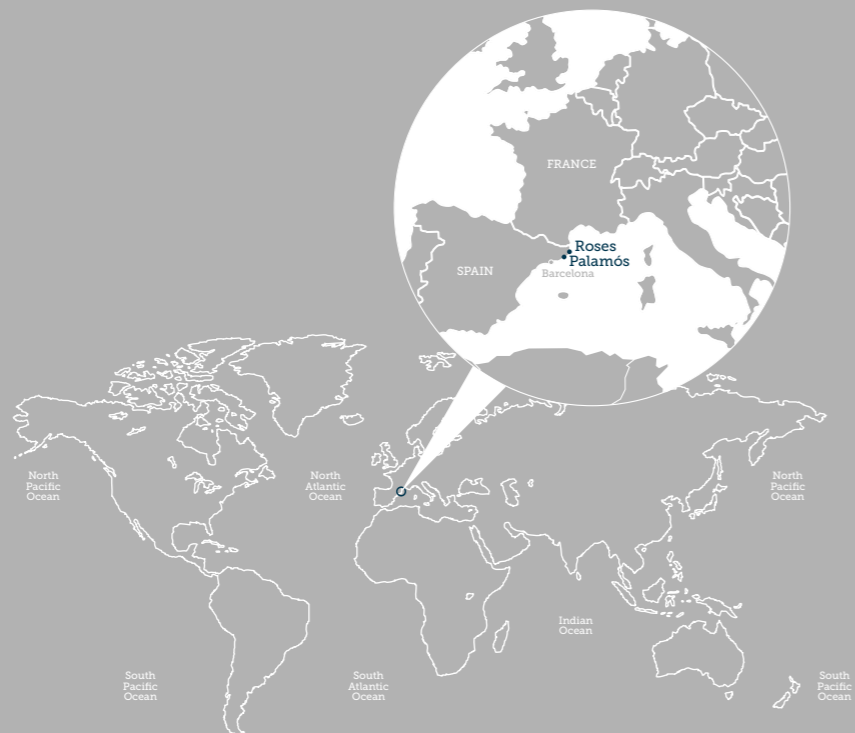

After Barcelona, Palamós is the second major port in Catalonia.

Roses

Roses is an essentially Mediterranean town situated on a unique bay, surrounded by two Natural Parks of great landscape richness and diversity. The town is in the north of the Costa Brava, about 30 km from France, 65 km from Girona and 160 km from Barcelona.

Roses Bay is listed by UNESCO as one of "the most beautiful bays in the world".

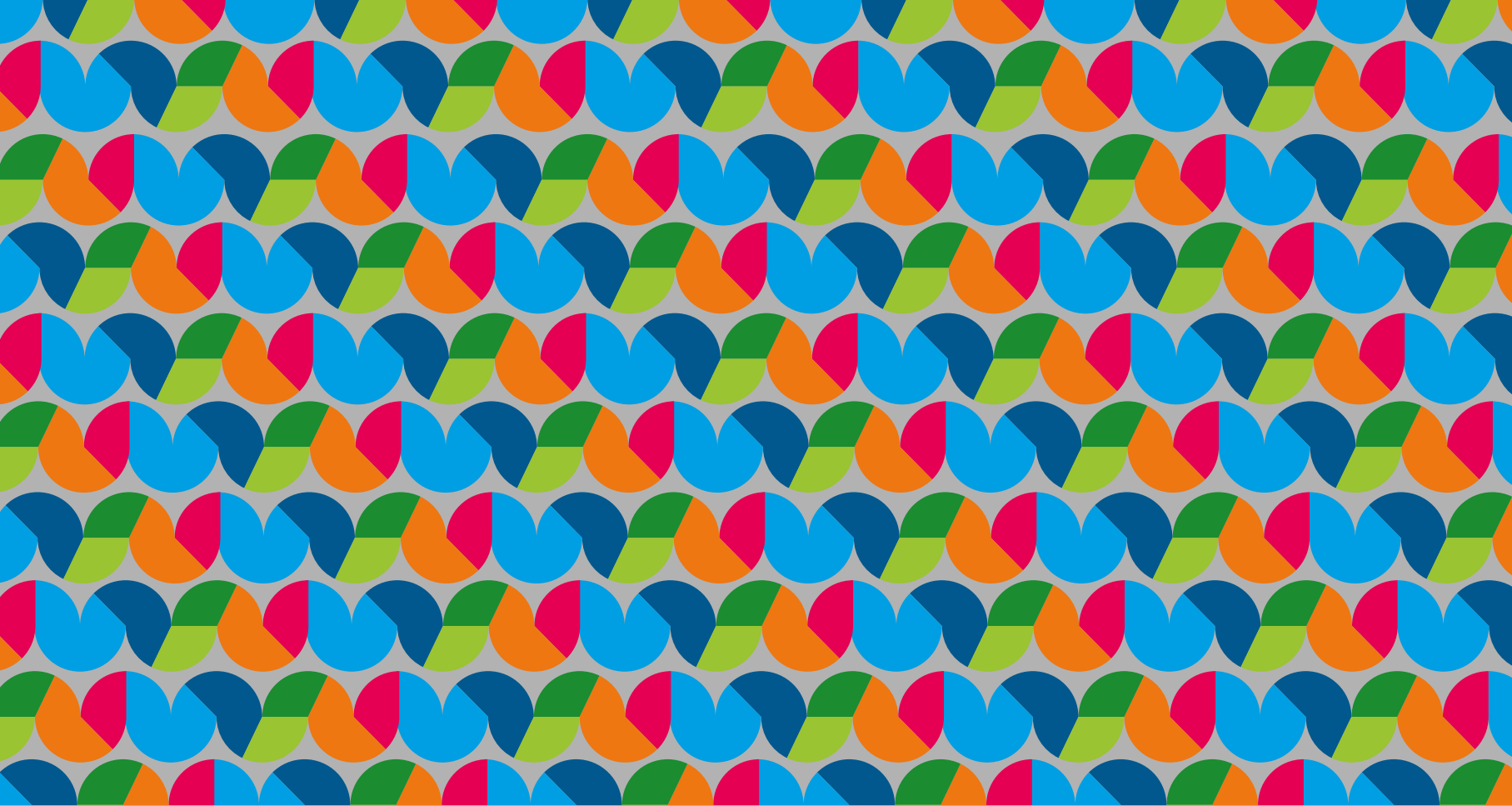
